ASDA 24 Hour Alcohol Licence? Chris Skidmore - listening to you

ASDA is proposing to introduce a 24 hour alcohol licensing. Your local councillors Nick Barrett and Tony Olpin, together with Prospective Conservative MP Chris Skidmore, have launched a campaign to ensure that local residents of Barrs Court are able to have their say on these proposals. Nick said: "The needs of residents should come first. We want Barrs Court to remain a residential community. There is a risk that these proposals might increase anti-social behaviour."

Nick, Tony and Chris are conducting a survey of residents, so that they can take their findings to ASDA. Chris Skidmore commented: "Local residents must be allowed to have their say on this. That's why we are launching this campaign and listening to your views".

Along with many local residents, Tony and Nick are also concerned that shopping trolleys are being taken from ASDA car park and being dumped in the local neighbourhood. They want to ensure that ASDA keeps the trolleys within the store by better securing the trolleys. Tony said: "There are several ways in which the trolleys could be made more secure. One idea is to introduce a magnetic strip around the car park, which stops the trolleys from leaving- as ASDA have done in Swindon. Dumped trolleys are an eyesore and something needs to be done to change this."

As part of their campaign on ASDA licensing hours, Nick and Tony also want to make a full report of what improvements can be made to the ASDA superstore to benefit the local neighbourhood.
